## Instructions to candidates:

The MUET Writing Paper consists of two (2) questions. Question 1 tests on the transfer of information from a non-linear source, such as charts, tables and other graphic materials, to linear text. Question 2 tests on extended writing. Answer both questions.

You will be assessed on task fulfilment, language and organisation.

## Question 1

Figure 2: Size of the Areas of Depletion in Three Different Wetlands between 2011 and 2015

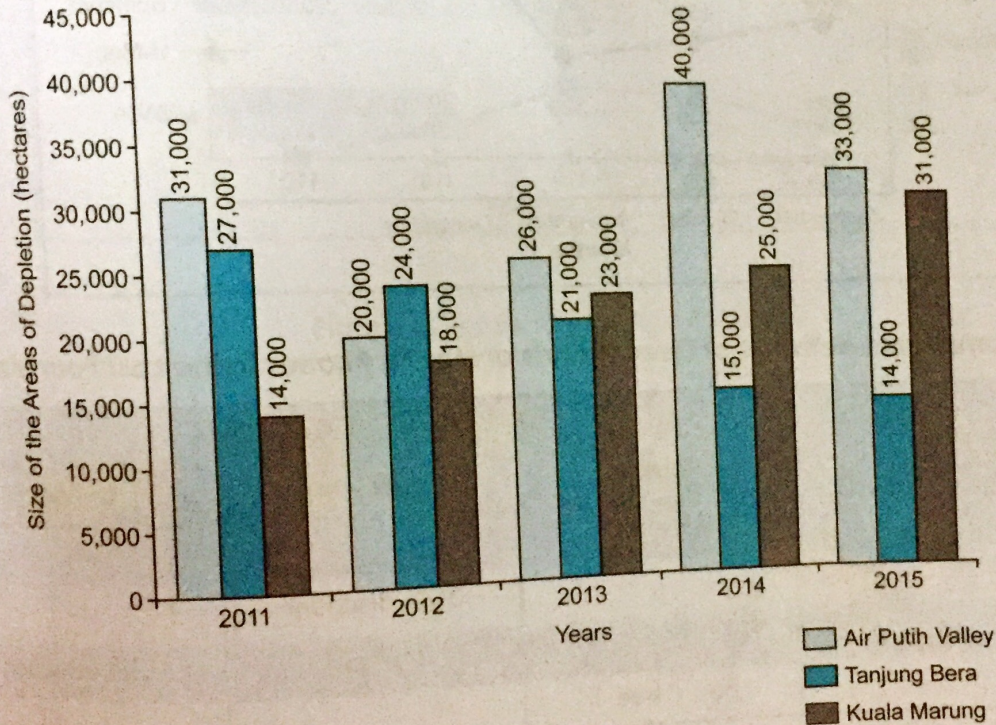
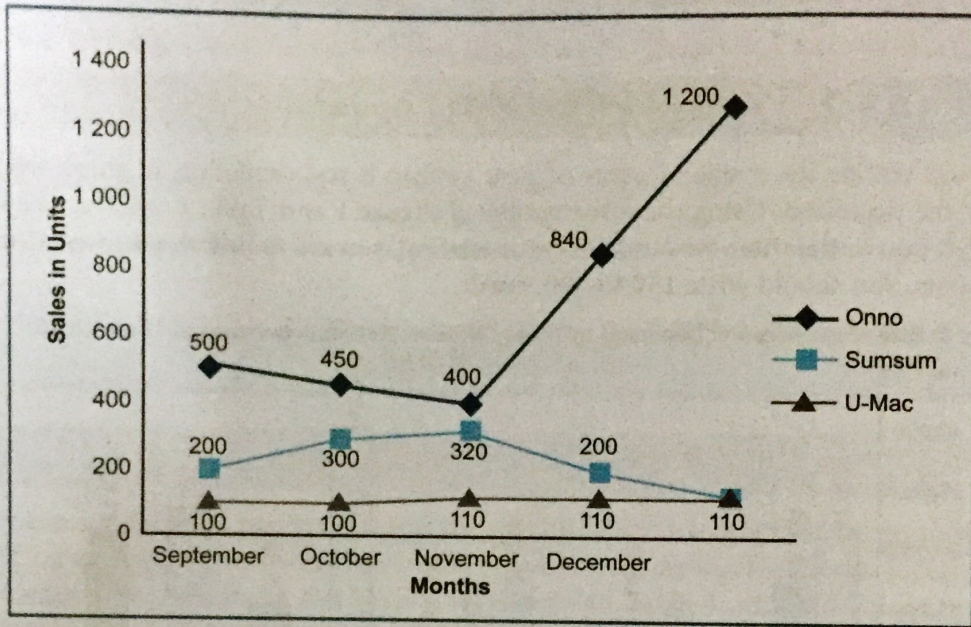

Figure 1: Types of Exercise in 2010

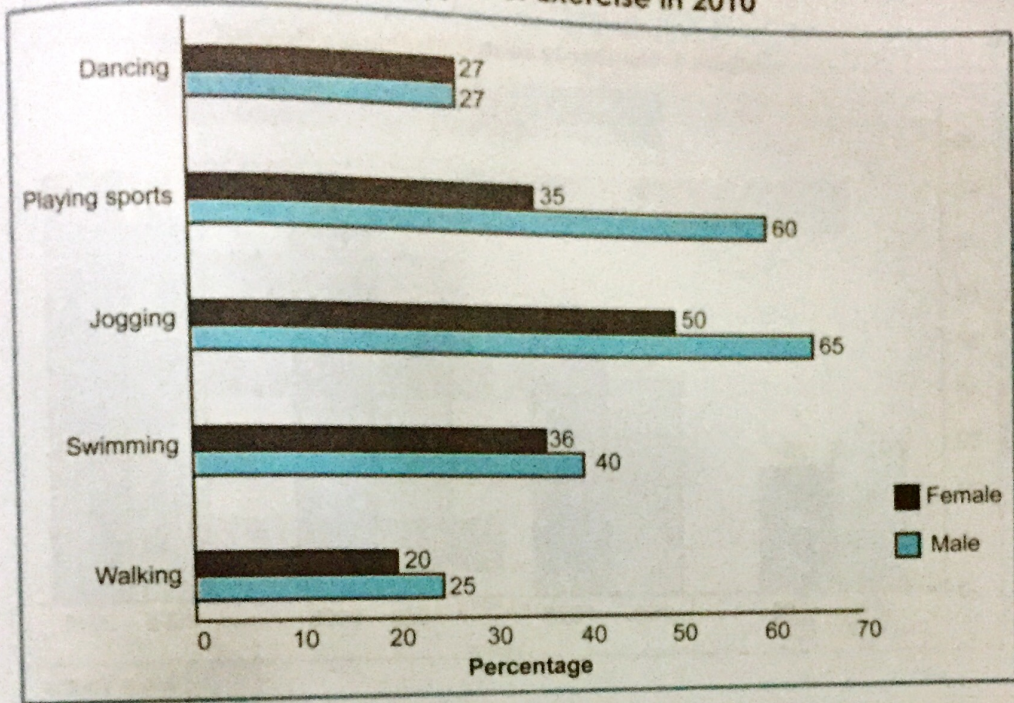
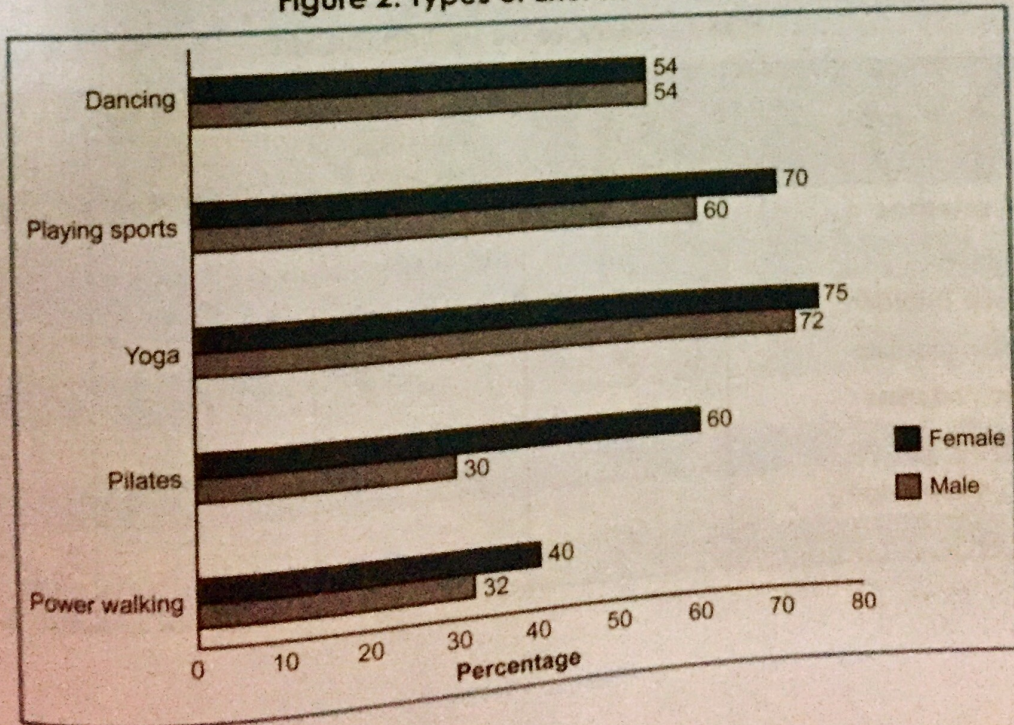
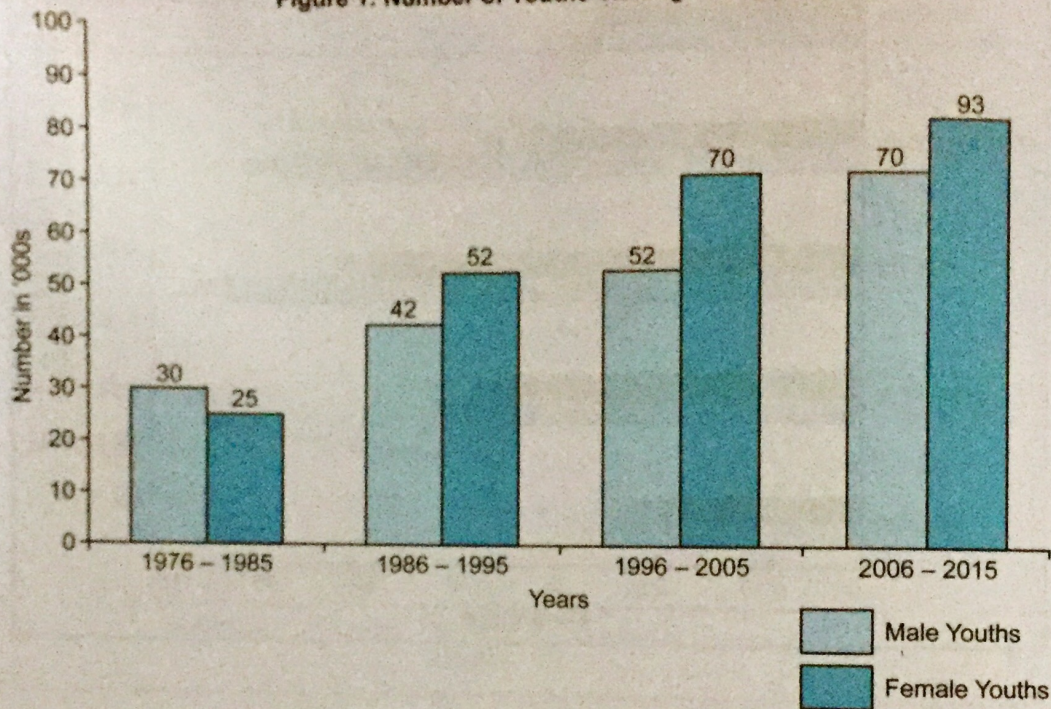


Figure 2: Types of Exercise in 2014

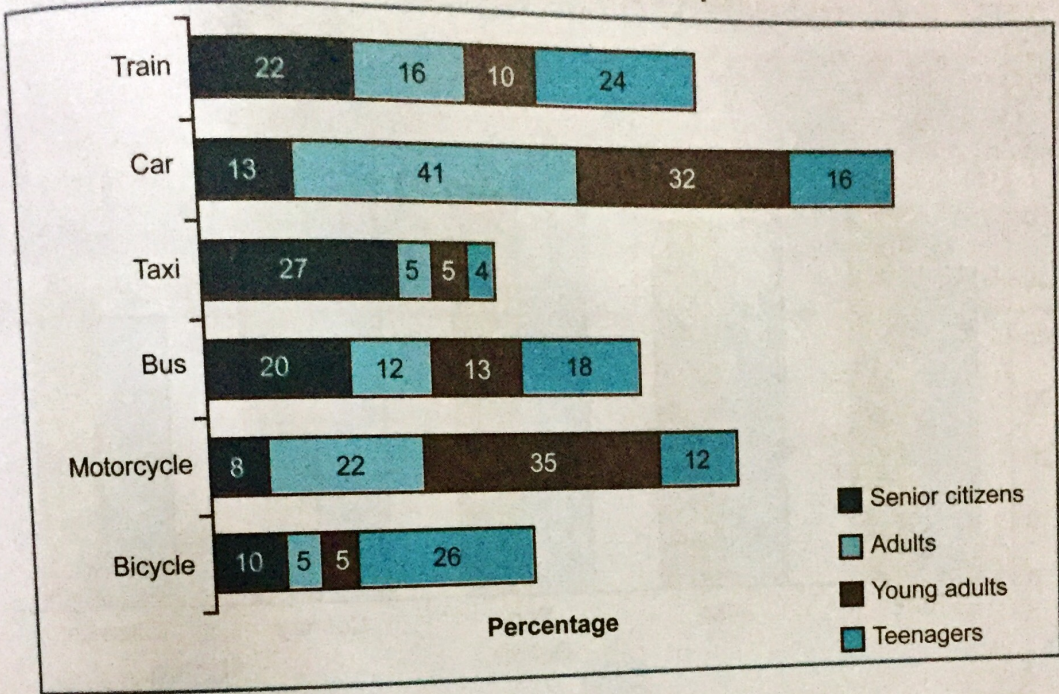

Figure 1: Music Genres of Youths in 1975

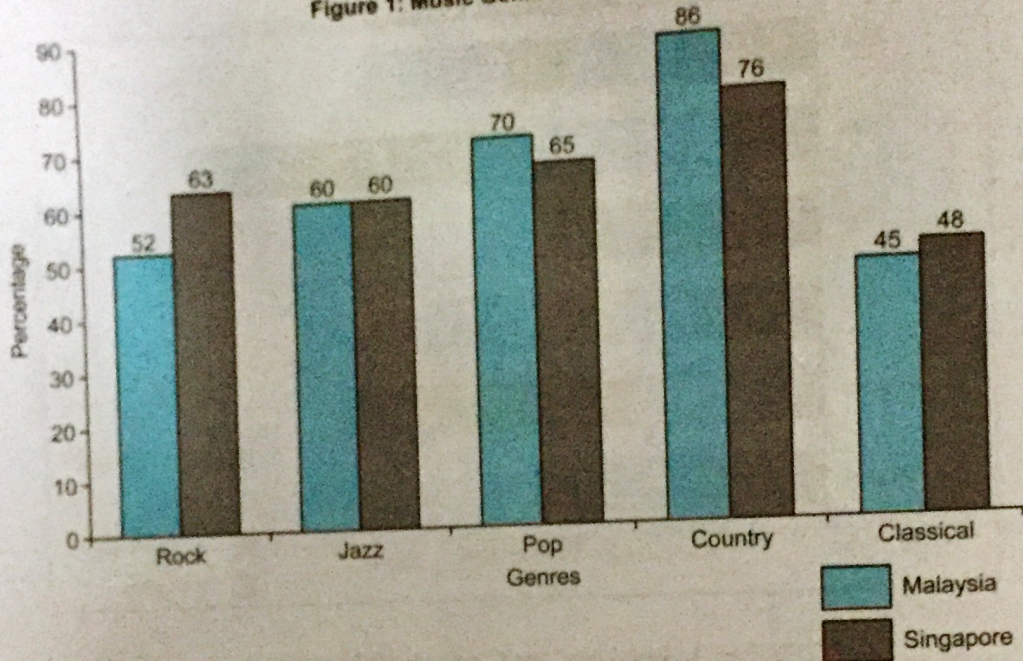
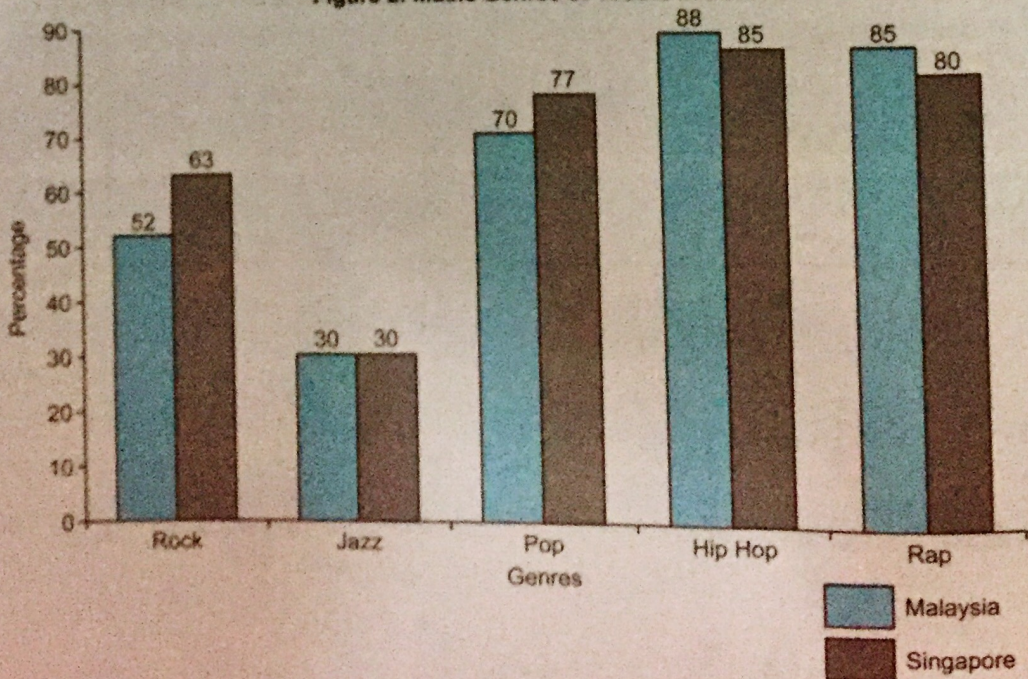


Figure 2: Music Genres of Youths in 2015



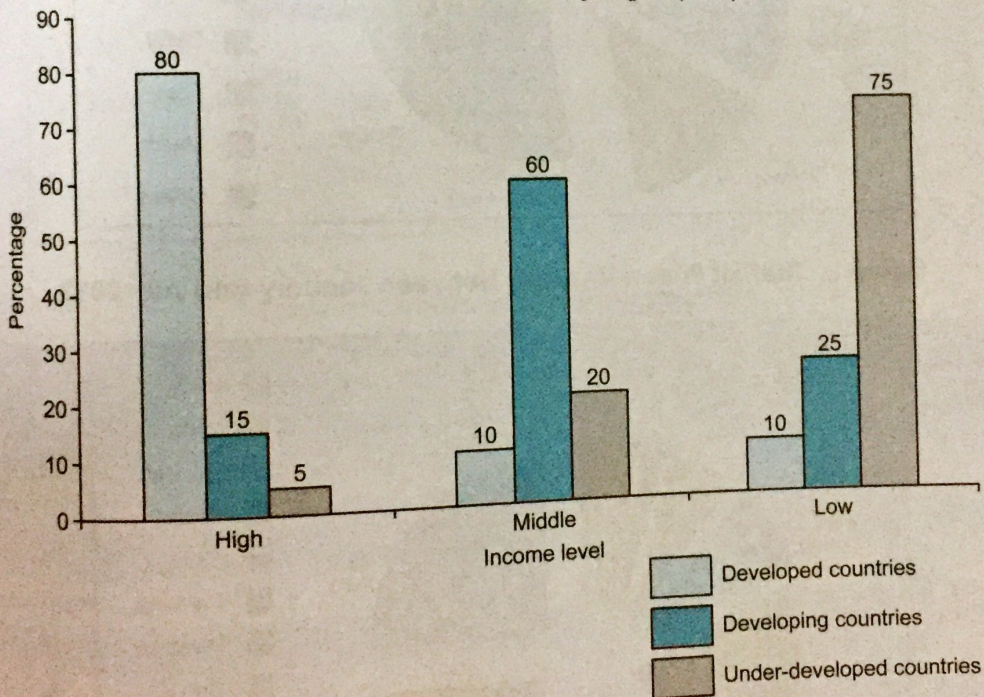

**Figure 1: Income Level by Region (2015)**

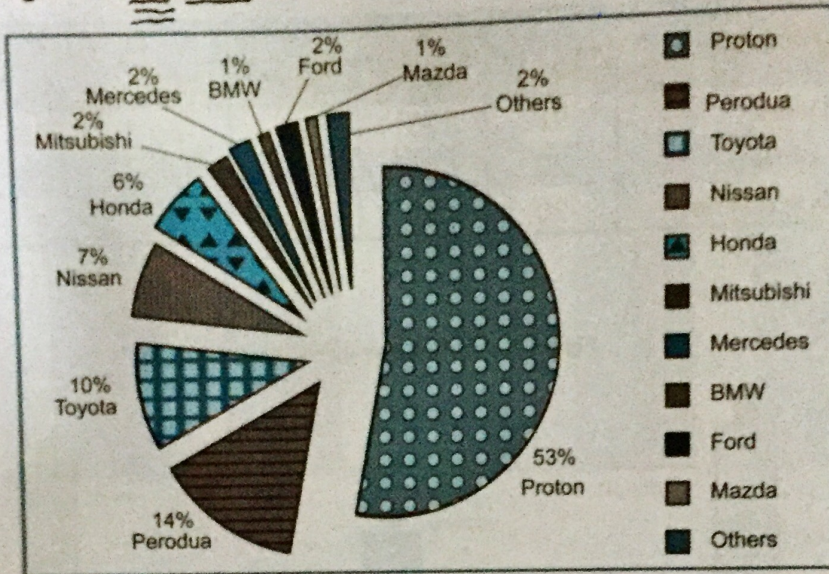




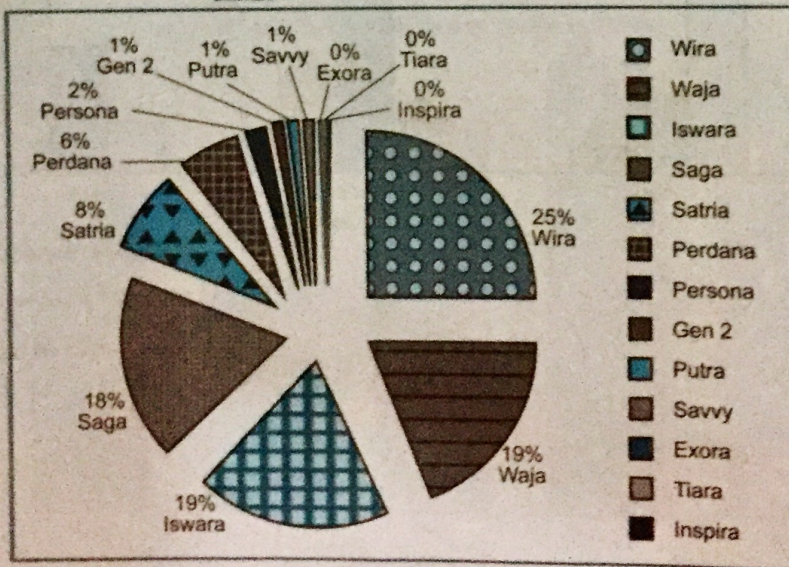

**Figure 1: Car Thefts in Malaysia between January and July 2012**



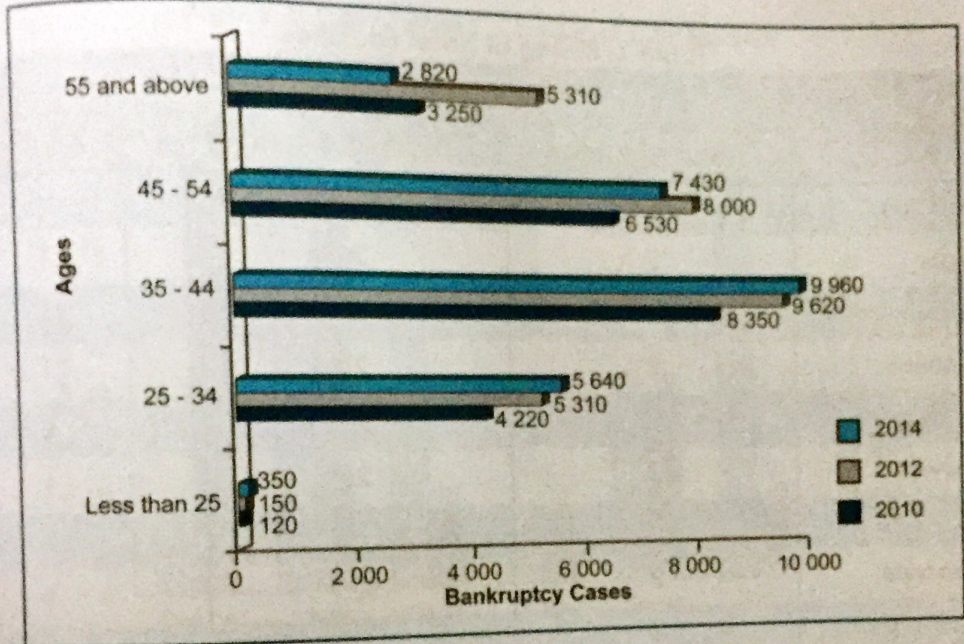

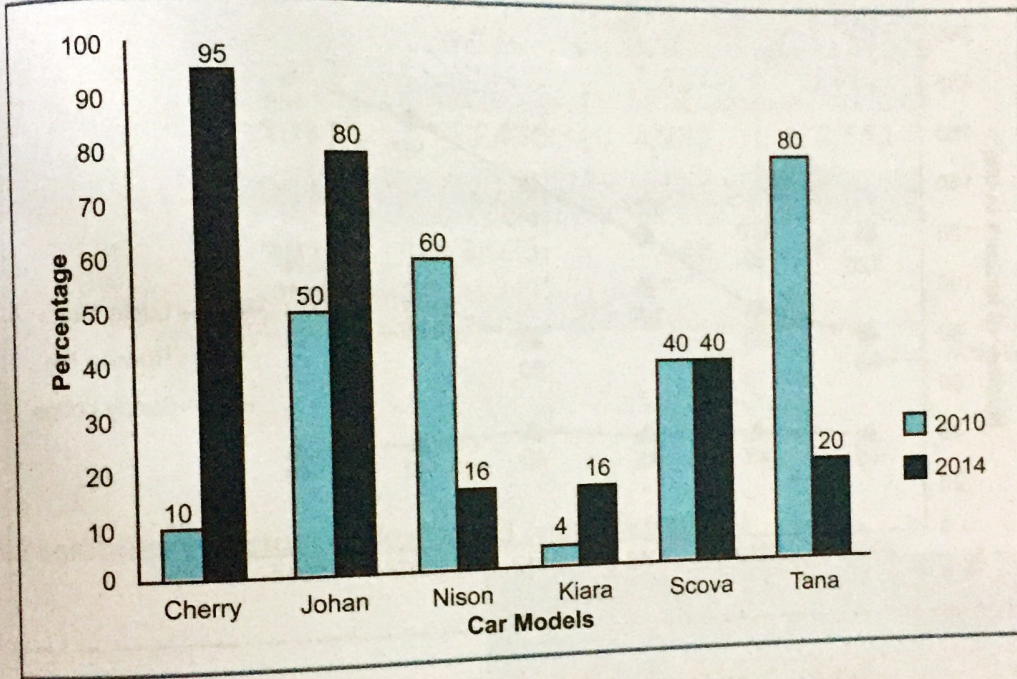

**Figure 1: Car Owners' Choice of Car Models**



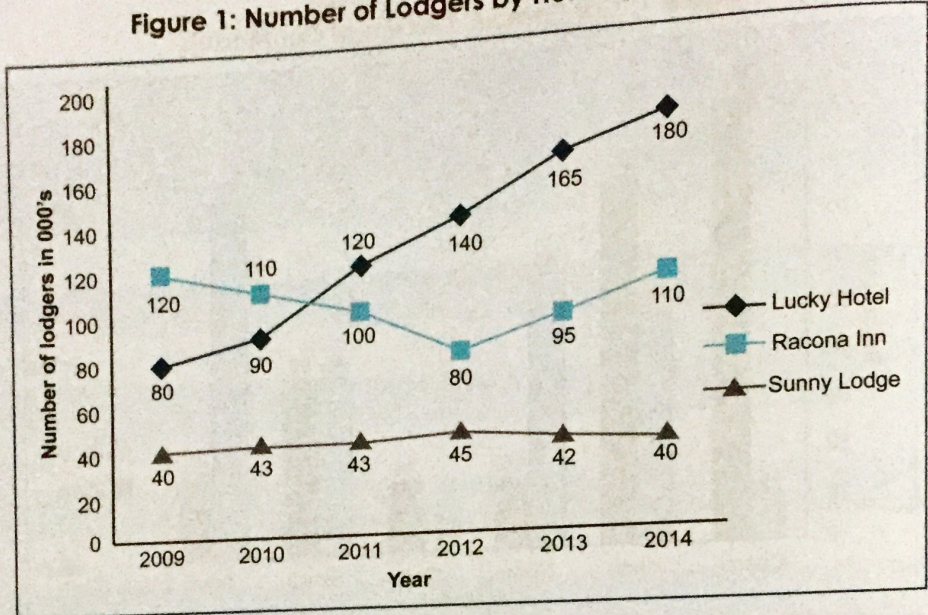

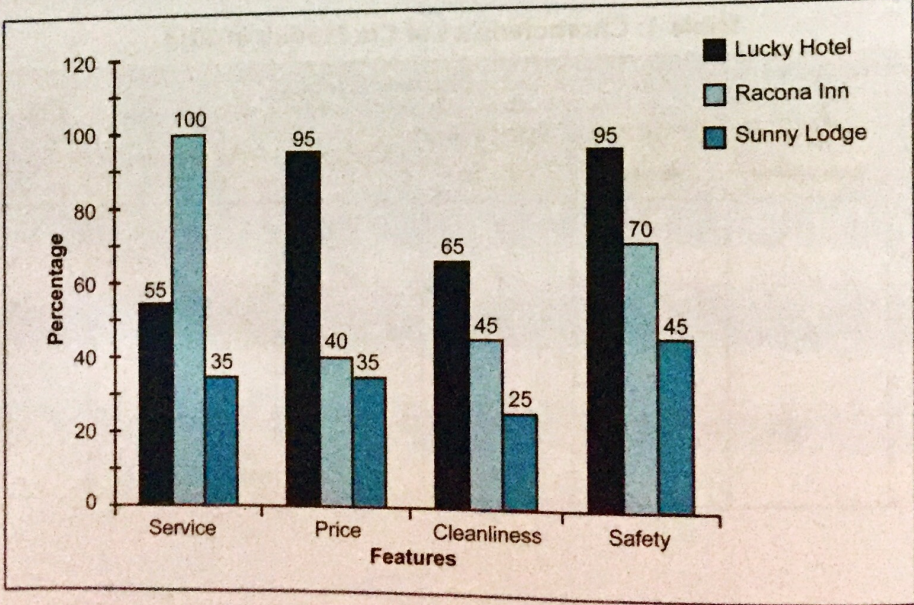
