

Figure 1: Sales of Three Brands of Mobile Phones in the Last Quarter of 2014



Figure 1: Types of Exercise in 2010





Figure 2: Types of Exercise in 2014



Figure 1: Choice of Transport







Figure 1: Car Thefts in Malaysia between January and July 2012





Figure 2: Theft of Proton Vehicles between January and July 2012

Figure 1: Bankruptcy Cases of the Different Age Groups



Figure 1: Car Owners' Choice of Car Models



Figure 1: Number of Lodgers by Hotels (2009 – 2014)





Figure 2: Lodgers' Rating of Satisfaction for 2014
